NSED has arranged with the local municipal governments to conduct the NSED Member Representative elections. However, the NSED Member Representative election is not a municipal office and it will have a separate ballot. Voters do not need to be qualified to vote in the city’s elections to be eligible to vote in the NSED election. Any registered voter who resides in a state election precinct that encompasses the member community, even if they live outside the community’s municipal limits, is eligible to vote in the NSED Member Representative election. NSED Eligibility and Minimum Vote Requirements:

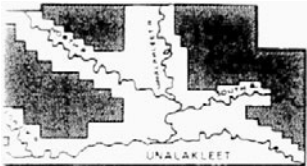
Candidate Eligibility: To be eligible as a candidate, an applicant:

- Must be a “resident fisher” of the community she or he wishes to represent, which is an individual:
 - with recent (within 10 years prior to the election), documented commercial or subsistence fishing activity;
 - who is a registered voter residing within the state precinct boundaries encompassing the member community, where the applicant maintains a mailing address and permanent domicile in the member community; and
 - eligible to receive an Alaska Permanent Fund Dividend, where the individual spends at least 20 days each month within the community from which they are filing for election and once elected, with the exception of regular vacations, travel for work-related business, board/commission obligations or medical reasons; and where the individual has resided for at least one (1) year immediately prior to the election.
- May not be currently employed by NSED in a regular position; and
- Must have “good moral character,” which means that an individual:
 - is eligible for election as set forth in Article Five, Section 6 (see candidacy packet for more information);
 - has a history free of any felony convictions, including guilty pleas or pleas of nolo contendere, within the last 10 years;
 - has a criminal history free of any misdemeanor controlled substance convictions, including guilty pleas or pleas of nolo contendere, within the last 10 years; and
 - is able to pass a drug screen test, prior to the election, which is administered in accordance with NSED’s employee drug and alcohol testing policies.

To determine eligibility, each applicant must complete a “Member Representative Candidacy Statement” and consent to a background check and drug test. You may pick up a candidacy packet with these forms and additional information from the city office or from the NSED Liaison in your community. Packets will be available by August 14, 2026.

Minimum Vote: The candidate receiving the highest number of votes and over 40% of the total votes cast shall be the elected NSED Member Representative.

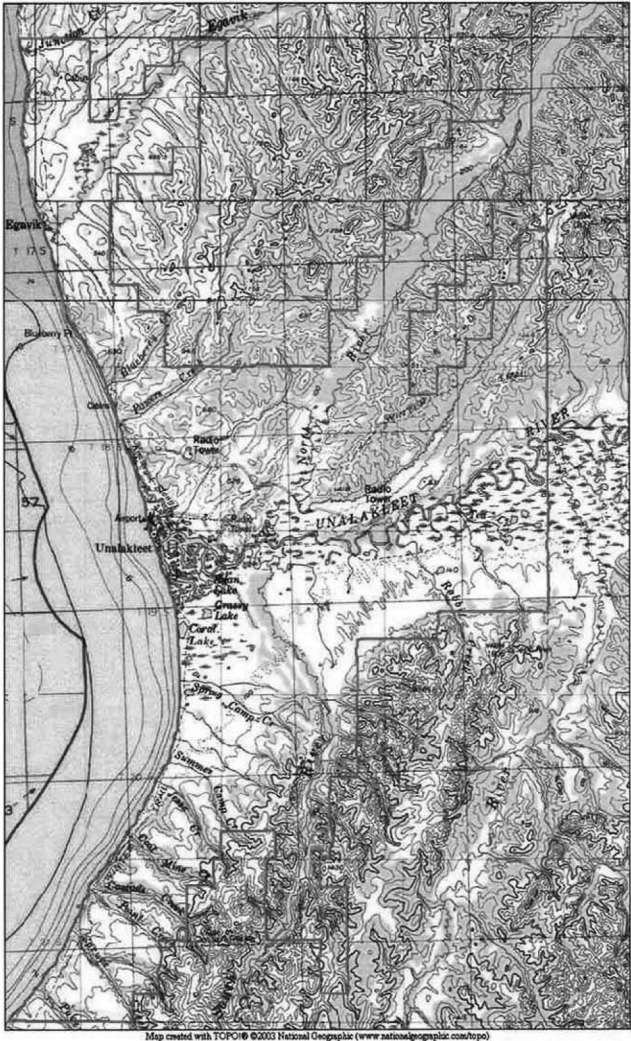

ballots confirmed existing trends. In the U.S. Senate race, Democratic challenger Mary Peltola has 48.1 percent of the vote, and incumbent Republican Sen. Dan Sullivan has 42.7 percent. In the No. 3 spot is

Republican challenger Dan J. Sullivan of Petersburg, with 2.4 percent. The fourth spot is currently held by progressive Democrat David Leslie, with 1.1 percent. If Leslie withdraws or if late-counted votes alter election-day trends, his spot would be taken by conservative Republican Gerald

Heikes, who sat just 17 votes behind Leslie on Thursday. In the U.S. House race, Republican Rep. Nick Begich III has 46.1 percent of the vote, ahead of independent challenger Bill Hill, with 30.9 percent. Democratic challenger Matt Schultz was in third with 8 percent

and federal inmate Eric Hafner, a Democratic candidate, was in fourth with 3.8 percent. Schultz has already suspended his campaign and is expected to withdraw, which would elevate fifth-place finisher John Williams, a Fairbanks Democrat with 2.6 percent of the vote. Republican Clay Strick-

land was in sixth with 2.4 percent.
