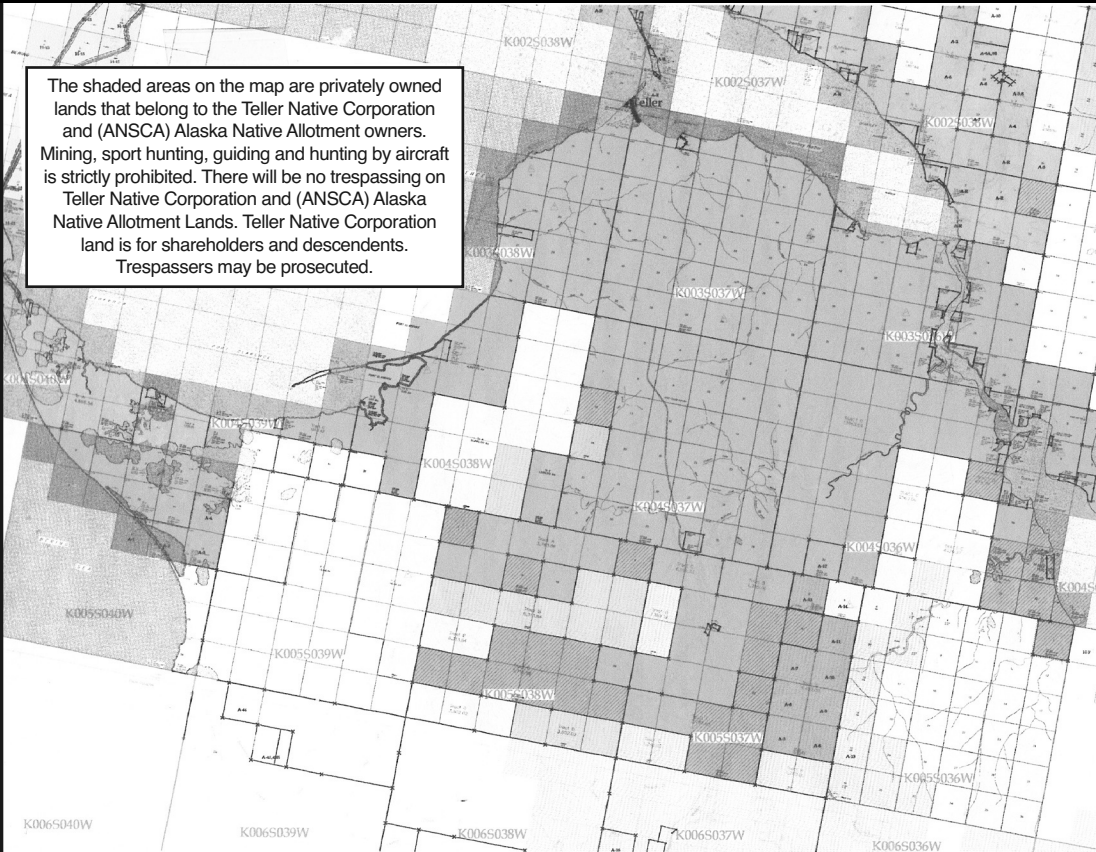

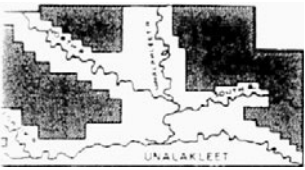

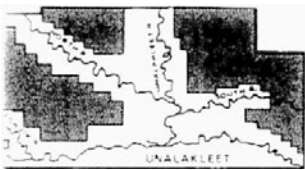

That left the eighth-place primary finisher, Libertarian candidate Jim McDermott of Fairbanks, to advance to the November election as the fourth of four candidates despite earning just 1.2% of the primary vote among 15 candidates overall. A call to McDermott’s listed phone went directly to voicemail at 5:50 p.m. Monday.

Ranked choice voting reduces the chances that candidates from the same party will split available voters and improve the odds for a candidate from a different party, but the system does not eliminate that chance entirely.

Since 2022, when Alaska began using the current system, a significant number of voters have continued to rank just one candidate.

As a result, political parties have pressured lower-finishing primary candidates to withdraw ahead of the general election in order to consolidate support.

Williams, by phone from Fairbanks, said he talked with “a lot” of people from the Alaska Democratic Party and with Hill before making his decision.

“I’m going to step away because that’s the best thing for Alaska,” he said, not because of any particular request that he quit.

Williams said he supports Alaska’s ranked choice election system, and he said he was discouraged by the number of Democratic Party officials who appeared to be acting against democratic values — the idea that voters, not political parties, decide candidates.

“I almost put my heels in the sand but ultimately decided not to,” he said.

“If (Hill) wins, he wins. If he loses, it’s not going to be because of me,” Williams said.
